

School Bus Monitors help to ensure that all students have a safe bus ride to and from school. Senior students volunteer to become bus monitors and are there to help the younger students get on and off the bus and assist the bus driver if any problems arise on the trip to or from school. There are 1-2 bus monitors per bus and a different student can volunteer to be the bus monitor each month.
